SRO-08. The Government hereby direct that in the Jammu and Kashmir Government Medical Colleges (selection of candidates for post graduate Degree/ Diploma Courses) Procedure Order 1995 issued vide SRO 158 dated 12th July 1995 as amended vide Notification SRO 57 dated 31-01-2002 and Notification SRO 364 dated 21st October, 2003 for the provisions to sub clause (V) of clause 3 the following provisions shall be substituted namely:-

“ provided that Doctors who have done their Post Graduate or Diploma Courses in any specialty at the Government expenses shall be entitled to seek admission for undergoing further Post Graduate or Diploma in another specialty in the State Medical Institution on payment of such fee as may be notified by the Government from time to time;

Provided further that the Doctors who are doing Post Graduation / Diploma Courses in any specialty at the Government expenses shall not be eligible to apply for undergoing Post Graduate Courses in any other specialty in the State medical institutions till completion of their Post Graduation/ Diploma Courses, as the case may be.”
